On 01/13/2020, at about 1545 hrs, Kennewick PD Commander Chris Guerrero contacted me on my personnel cell phone and advised he had just left Monica Hatcher's residence with some firearms and boxes of ammunition and was en-route to my office to drop off these items as they belong to the Benton County Sheriff's Office. It was believed these items were assigned to Sheriff Jerry Hatcher, and Monica Hatcher had contacted Kennewick PD to have these items removed from the residence.

Commander Guerrero advised they had also accepted other firearms from Monica Hatcher that were believed to be personal firearms of Sheriff Hatcher, please see Kennewick PD case #19-40197.

I met Commander's Guerrero and Scott Child outside in the secured compound, at the 104-building where our office stores ammunition. I accepted from them two firearms as follows:

- 1.1-Benelli M-4, 12-gauge tactical shotgun with a light and 6-shotgun shells on a side-saddle, serial #Y028903.
- 2.1-BCM MOD BCM4 rifle, with a Surefire suppressor and Aimpoint optic, serial #0563233.

I also accepted 15-cases of ammunition from them. All of the cases were marked Benton County Sheriff or Sheriff's Office on the mailing stickers. These boxes of ammunition were placed inside of the 104-building with signs not to be used until further notice. The ammunition is listed as follows:

- 1.1-case of CCI 22-LR (Unopened). The markings showed 50 each.
- 2.1-case Hornady .308 Win - 200 rounds (Unopened)
- 3.1-500 round case of Federal .308 Win. (Open case, with no boxes missing)
- 4.4-1000 round cases of Federal 40 caliber (All unopened)
- 5.1-1000 round case of Federal 9mm Luger (Unopened)
- 6.6-500 round cases of Federal .223. (One case is opened with 3-20 round boxes missing)
- 7.1-200 round case of 45-auto (Unopened) \*\*Note: This case had the name "Bill Whitten" listed on the mailing sticker, with an address of 4802 W. 8th Ave, Kennewick. I contacted Commander Guerrero and advised him this case was addressed to the above and not Benton County Sheriff's Office. (I returned this case back to Commander Guerrero at Kennewick PD on 01/14/2020.)

Commander Guerrero provided a property log of the items turned over to the Sheriff's Office, which all three of the commanders signed and will be placed into the case file for this event. I photographed all of the boxes of ammunition and the two firearms, and the KPD property log, which these photos will be placed into a photo log on the Sheriff's Office All-Patrol (N:) Drive, under BCSO case #20-00768. The two firearms were turned over to Detective Todd Carlson for him to inventory and place into our arms room. Det. Carlson was advised the 2-firearms are not to be assigned to anyone until further notice.
